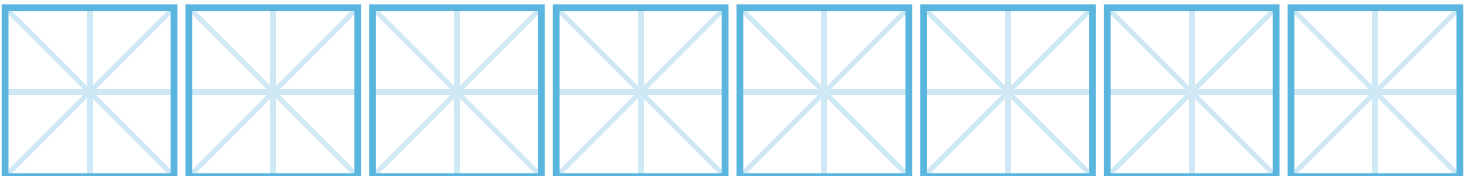
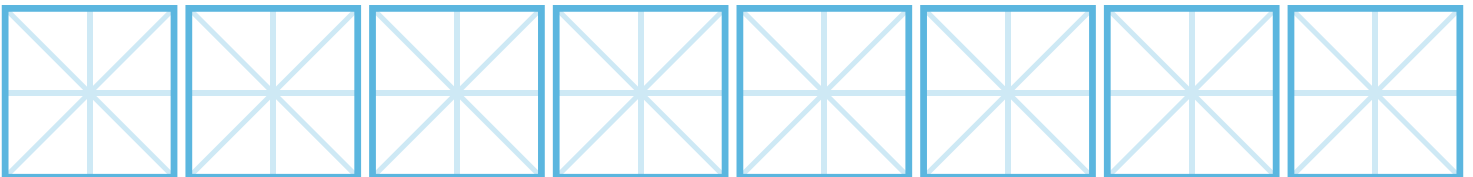

General Chinese Writing Guidelines

Write from top to bottom, left to right • Horizontal strokes before vertical strokes • Pass-through strokes last
For diagonals: right to left, before left to right • Center strokes first in vertically symmetrical characters
Outside before inside when enclosing • Left vertical stroke first on enclosures • Bottom enclosures last
Dots and minor strokes last
